2022 Fishin' Fiesta BBQ Cook-Off Contest Rules

The Fishin' Fiesta BBQ Cook-Off contest is sponsored by the Freeport Host Lions Club Foundation.

The contest will be held at the Freeport Municipal Park on July 1st & 2nd.

Freeport Municipal Park / 421 N. Brazosport Blvd / Freeport, TX 77541

Contest Rules are as follows:

- Entries must be received by June 29, 2022.
 Please mail entries to: Freeport Host Lions Foundation, PO Box 2434, Freeport, TX 77541 or email entries to: fishinfiestabbq@gmail.com or drop off in person
- 2. All sites must submit an original entry form with payment. Entry fees are not refundable and must accompany entry form. Entry fees are one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per team.
- 3. Check-in and set-up will begin at 9:00am on Thursday, June 30th for reserved sites. Teams that have been with us since 2012 will have first choice to retain their site. Unassigned teams may select sites after 10:00am on a first-come-first-serve basis on Friday, July 1st. **No electricity is provided** so you need to have your own generator. We do have a couple of spots that you can get water.
 - A cooks meeting will be held Friday, July 1st at 7:00pm at the park at the River Place Civic Center.
- 4. No pre-seasoned or pre-cooked meats will be allowed. For all cooking requirements check IBCA website for complete rules. https://ibcabbq.org/organization-documents/
 Each pit must be equipped with at least a 10lb. Multipurpose and/or ABC fire extinguisher.
- 5. The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and visitors. Absolutely no firearms or explosives will be allowed. Amplification equipment should be used in moderation and not to interfere with live entertainment. ALL SUCH EQUIPMENT WILL BE TURNED OFF BY MIDNIGHT. City Ordinance states that "NO GLASS CONTAINERS" (except food containers within site assignment) are allowed within the park area. You will be allowed to bring in your own beer.

Live Bands are not allowed in the BBQ area.

Abuse of the rules will result in disqualification and will be asked to leave the BBQ grounds.

- 6. The Freeport Host Lions Foundation will not be responsible for theft or damage to equipment, supplies or personal belongings while participating in this event.
- 7. The decisions of the BBQ Cook-Off Chairperson and judges are final.
- 8. Each team will be allowed 2 vehicles and one sleeping quarter within the assigned site. You must display the IBCA Cook-Off sticker on the top left-hand side of your windshield. **All other vehicles must be parked out side the assigned site.** All spaces will be approximately 30' x 30'. All teams must supply some form of grease catch pan with absorbent for each pit.

9. Rod & Reels will be awarded for 1st through 10th Place for Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs and One (1) Chicken Half. Rods & Reels will be awarded for 1st through 3rd Place for Beans beginning Saturday at approximately 5:00pm.

Rules And Important Information For Parent and Child

July 2, 2022

Anyone between the ages of 5 and 17 years of age may participate! Each child will be provided with a variety of seasonings. No one under the age of 5 or over the age of 17 by July 2nd, 2022 may participate. The judging age group are Junior's 5-10 and Senior's 11-17.

A completed entry form and \$20 entry fee is required to participate. We ask that you please try to send in your entry form prior to the BBQ. The first 20 entries registered will participate in Kid's Que. Each child cooking must have adult supervision with them at all times.

Check-in will begin at 8:15 am on Saturday, July 2nd; Cook's meeting at 8:30 am and turn-in will be at 9:45 am. Parents will be allowed to help start the fire, and they can help you turn the chops if you aren't tall enough to do so without burning yourself. A bar-b-que pit may be furnished by the Lions' Club, their parents BBQ pit or a team sponsor.

The competition meat (Pork Chop) will be provided by Fishin' Fiesta and the child will receive two (2) 1-1/2" inch pork chops. No garnish is allowed in the competition meat turn-in box. These chops may be seasoned in any way using the seasonings provided OR you may bring your own seasoning. Competition meat, which is the Pork Chop that each contestant will cook, will be turn in at 9:45 am.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each category will win a Trophy fishing pole. All contestants will earn an Award of Participation in each category; and each child will receive a ticket for a chance to win a door prize.

Pork Chop Turn-In: 9:45 am
