

SABBQ Cooker Information Sheet

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Bar-B-Que Cook-Off (SABBQ) is a true championship cooking event and the largest IBCA sanctioned cook-off featuring over 300 teams of the world's best cookers and pitmasters. Tens of thousands of visitors soak up live music, vendor shopping, fun activities and great BBQ all weekend.

The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo is a non-profit organization supporting Texas youth education and agriculture. Because of the dedication and efforts of over 6,000 volunteers, the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo is able to provide financial support to Texas youth seeking higher education as well as positively influence the agriculture industry in Texas. To date, the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo educational commitment totals over \$198 million with a record \$12 million committed in 2018 in the form of scholarships, grants, endowments, auctions, a calf scramble program and show premiums paid to youth. 100% of all proceeds from SABBQ benefit the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Scholarship Fund.

The SABBQ Grand Champion will also receive:



- Championship Belt Buckle, Banner & Flag, and 5 Monogrammed Award Aprons
- Invitation and free space to: the 2020 SABBQ; 2020 Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo World's Championship BBQ Cook-Off; 2019 BBQ Austin; Invitation to the American Royal BBQ Contest in Kansas City, Missouri; and an entry into the lottery for a chance to receive an invitation to the Jack Daniel's Barbeque Championship

The entry fee for each 40 x 40 space is only \$675 and is due and payable at the time of registration. Each space comes with a 30 amp electric service. Water is available. Each Jackpot entry will be \$50 each. Jackpot contests provide cash payouts for the top three places in each category. Registration must be completed online at www.SARodeo.com/BBQ.

Each TEAM entry will receive a packet at least 2 weeks before the event that will include:

- 5 wristbands per space to designate team members, valid for Friday and Saturday.
- 2 permitted parking passes per space to allow parking on-site.
- 2 off-site parking passes per space to allow free entry to paid parking lots (with access to shuttle service). A gate ticket or team wristband will be required if arrival is during times event is open to the general public
- 10 weekend passes per each space, valid for Friday and Saturday.

Kash for Kids (K4K) is an opportunity for BBQ teams to participate and compete in raising funds for the San Antonio Livestock Exposition, Inc. Scholarship Fund through tips and donations. K4K offers prizes and potential FREE entries to SABBQ.

SABBQ personnel will deliver and collect a K4K sealed container to participating team spaces. Simply collect donations and tips in the provided K4K bucket. The team who collects the most money will be declared the overall winner and will be recognized with an award banner and one award belt buckle at the following year's event.

Teams that raise \$1,300 to \$2,499 dollars will be awarded ONE (1) FREE space for the 24th Annual SABBQ. Teams that raise \$2,500 dollars or more will be awarded TWO (2) FREE spaces for the 24th Annual SABBQ.



We are happy, proud and thrilled to host the 3rd annual San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Buckaroo Que taking place on Saturday, January 26, 2019, starting at 11:00 am.

This is a KIDS COOK-OFF! Parental supervision is required, however, the child will be responsible for prepping,

seasoning, cooking and presenting their entry. Contest is open to children ages 4-17 years.

Kids will cook pork chops provided by SABBQ on provided charcoal grills in the Buckaroo Que Area. Complete rules provided upon registration. Entry fee is only \$50 per child. Registration must be completed online at www.SARodeo.com/BBQ.
