Rules:

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, all rules of IBCA apply.

- 3. 75% of Registration will be paid out as prize money. Pot may grow depending on sponsorships.
- 4. Limited to 100 teams
- 5. Spaces are 30' x 40'. Additional spaces available depending on number of teams. Each additional space is \$100 (max 1 extra space).
- 6. 5 entry wristbands will be provided per space. Additional wristband are \$10 each.
- 7. Private portable toilets must be booked in advance. Cost is \$125/toilet. The port able toilet must fit inside your space.
- 8. Quiet Hours begin at 11:00 pm each night. At all other times music and other noise must be kept at a level not to infringe on other teams.
- 9. Head Cooks are responsible for ensuring everyone on their team and part of there group displays appropriate behavior at all times.
- 10. Water is available on site.
- 11. No power will be provided.
- 12. Ice will be available for sale at any time prior to the beginning of quiet hours. All ice other than what teams bring during move in must be purchased from the Pearland Area Dad's Club.
- 13. All food must be prepared on site. There is no meat inspection.
- 14. Have fun!!! Yes, it's a rule.
