## **22nd Annual Wild West Festival BBQ Cook-Off Short Version of IBCA Rules**

#### **Special Notice to Participants:** Only one (1) entry per pit



- 1. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 4 team members.
- 2. Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc. will not be allowed prior to start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter.
- 3. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start natural substance but not to complete cooking. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.
- 4. Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. No Tent stakes can be driven into the asphalt. All trash must be picked up before departure.
- 5. Cook's Meeting will be held: Friday Night at 8:30 p.m. in the Judging area HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND
  - a. 7:00 p.m.— Steak (Friday night)
  - b. 11:00 a.m.— Beans
  - c. 12:00 p.m.— One Chicken Halve: Fully jointed split chicken (with breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick)
  - b. 1:30 p.m.— Pork Spare Ribs: 7 individual pork spareribs
  - c. 3:00 p.m.— Brisket: 7 full slices
  - d. 4:00 p.m.— Dessert
- 6. BASED ON THE # OF COOKS, TURN-IN QUANTITIES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
- 7. NO GARNISH or SAUCE is allowed in the tray at turn-in.

You may cook with sauce but sauce cannot be ladled onto meat at turn-in.

- 8. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks and other building materials or props hauled away and all equipment removed from the site.
- 9. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. NO FOOD SALES OR SAMPLES may be given to the general public. (Promoter's call).
- 10. No extra vehicles shall be allowed in the pit area once pit is set up. Motor home is considered as one (1) vehicle. (All extra vehicles must be removed and parked outside of the cooking area).
- 11. No animals allowed in the judging area.
- 12. IBCA judging rules will apply.
- 13. Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft or any mishaps.
- 14. No Skateboards, skates, in-line skates, bicycles or golf carts allowed.
