- 3:00 P.M. Brisket (8 Full Slices)

Awards and Payouts following Judging

Each Meat Category: 1st=\$300, 2nd=\$200, 3rd=\$100

Grand Champion = \$300 & Reserve Champion \$200

IBCA Rules Will Apply

Sargent VFD BBQ Cook Off Rules

1. Entry fee is \$100 plus 1 fully cooked and warm brisket. Entry fee brisket to be turned in by 10:00 am on Saturday, April 23, 2022. Entry fee is for all three meat categories (brisket, ribs, chicken), to be paid at time of application. If teams wish to reserve a particular space, a \$15 reservation fee is also required. Otherwise, spaces are assigned on a 1st come-1st served basis. Please see attached map.
2. The head cook will be held responsible for the conduct of the team. Each team will be responsible for the cleaning of their space. All traffic lanes in the contest area must be kept open at all times.
3. All loud music must be turned down after 9:00 PM to a level so as not to conflict with live entertainment or disturb other cookers. Excessive alcohol use, noise, etc. can be grounds for disqualification and removal from property.
4. Teams must provide their own supplies. Sargent VFD will provide 30'W x 30'D space, trash bags and the containers for judging. NO RV HOOK UPS provided. Limited electricity available, may be provided on a first come, first served basis for an additional \$25 fee. Porta-Potties will be provided on site.
5. \$2,300 in cash prizes for Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion along with 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category.
6. One member from each team may be asked to participate in the judging. Chief Cooks are NOT allowed to judge, only a team member.
7. The preparation and cooking of any and all meats must be done on-site. Your entry may be inspected by Head Judge or contest committee at any time.
8. Entries will be judged based on aroma, color, texture, taste and over-all. Decisions of the committee and the judges are final.
9. Only one team cooking per pit. Fires must be of wood or wood substance. No electric or gas to be used, except for starting the wood fires. Cooks Choice entries are the exception and are not required to be cooked over wood. NO holes or dug pits are permitted. Fire extinguishers must be provided by cookers.
10. Any pre-paid cancellation must be made before April 1, 2022 for full refund. After that, your application fee becomes a donation to the Sargent VFD.
11. Sargent VFD or Matagorda County is not responsible for theft, damage of personal property or injury to any persons entered as contestants; or any of the contestant's family members or guests

MEAT AND COOKING OF MEAT

CHICKEN 12:00 Noon on Saturday, April 23, 2022

- 1) Chicken one (1) 1/2 fully jointed chicken MEAT side up (to include breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick). SKIN ON (No Cornish Game Hens)
- 2) **There is a plus or minus ten (10) minute window on all turn-in times. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

PORK SPARE RIBS 1:30 PM on Saturday, April 23, 2022

- 1) Eight (8) Individual Pork Spare Ribs No Babybacks or Country Style ribs able. Ribs must be placed in the tray MEAT side up lying parallel to the hinge

BRISKET 3:00 PM on Saturday, April 23, 2022

- 1) Eight (8) full slices, approximately 1/4" to 3/8" thick. Blocking brisket ends is allowed. The fat cap may be trimmed or cut away before the slices are placed into the tray. Brisket must be placed in the tray parallel to the hinge
