

### Cook-Off Rules:

#### 1. Cook-Off Dates and Location

#### 3. Entry Fees

- A. Each Cook-off Team will pay an entry fee of \$300. Please make check or money order payable to the <u>US Navy Seal Danny Dietz Foundation</u> or pay via PayPal (Friends and Family) <u>dannydietzcookoff@yahoo.com</u>
- B. Each team will receive 4 wristbands with their entry. Additional wristbands will be available for purchase at half price during the Cook Team Reception Friday night.

#### 4. Set-Up for Cooking Teams

Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup> 3 p.m. – 9 p.m. and Friday, September 10<sup>th</sup> 8 a.m. – 9 p.m. Please check-in upon your arrival. Vehicles must be removed from the aisles and fire lanes of the cook-off area. Overnight camping is allowed.

#### 5. Cooks Meeting

Friday, September 10, 2021 Head Cooks meeting is to be held at 6:00 p.m. at a location determined on site. Cook Off turn in times will be distributed at the Head Cooks Meeting.

#### 6. Clean-Up/Tear Down/Move-Out

All Teams are responsible for tear down and clean-up of their cooking spaces and areas. Tents must be removed from the cook-off area. All coals/embers must be extinguished before disposal! Do not leave ashes behind when you move out. If leaving after awards, please let us know so that you may be placed in the area that will be allowed to leave. If not notified, you will not be allowed to move until midnight Saturday night. Move out complete by noon Sunday, September 12<sup>th.</sup>

#### 7. Team Rules and Regulations

- A. No cars or trucks will be allowed in the aisles and fire lanes of the cook-off area after 9:00pm on Friday. All cars or trucks not secured in the Team's designated cook-off space shall be parked in the designated parking lot.
- B. Pits must be arranged in the Team space in such a manner that the public cannot walk by and touch or lean on a hot pit.
- C. Generators will **not** be allowed to operate under tents. All generators must be muffled, grounded, and in excellent working condition. If not, the Team will be instructed to turn it off and not allow it to be used during the duration of the cook off. No fuel shall be stored under covered area. Fuel storage must meet Fire Code.
- D. Any pet brought on premise must always be restrained by a leash or contained within the confines of the Team's space and out of public reach or contact.
- E. Team golf carts, four wheelers, mopeds, bicycles, gators or motorized recreational vehicles of any type will be allowed under special conditions. Segways will not be allowed. All safety features of the vehicle must be utilized, and the Manufacturer's recommended safety practices must be followed at all times. Persons that are simply "hanging on the side" will be asked to refrain from this activity, or risk removal of the vehicle from the cook-off area. Furthermore, the above stated vehicles are only allowed on the Cook-off grounds as a tool to be used by Teams to move supplies, equipment, and ice. Any Team that inthe opinion of Cook-off Officials is being used solely for entertainment purposes will be instructed to halt the activity. Refusal to do so will result in the vehicle being parked or removed from the Cook-off grounds for the duration of the Cook-off. Cruising the parking lot and speeding down the parking aisles will not be allowed and will be strictly enforced!
- F. Teams must lower sound levels of the music by 12:00 a.m. on both Friday and Saturday nights so it is not considered a nuisance to neighboring Teams. No one will be asked to leave the Team both or cook-off area on Friday and Saturday nights unless it is determined to be necessary by both Security Officers and DannyDietz Memorial Classic BBQ Cook-Off Committee Members' due to an individual's conduct. Once a personleaves the cook-off area for the parking area, you will be asked to proceed to your car and leave. No loitering will be allowed in the parking areas.

#### 8. COOK-OFF / OUTDOOR COOKING RESTRICTIONS

- A. **Open flame** or other devices emitting flame, fire or heat or any flammable or combustible liquids, gas, charcoal or other cooking that releases grease laden vapors **shall not** be permitted inside or located within10 ft. of the tent, canopy or membrane structures while open to the public.
- B. **Portable Fire Extinguishers** shall be provided by cook team. A minimum 2-A;10-BC multi-purpose fire extinguisher shallbe currently inspected and tagged by a Licensed Technician.
  - a. Two 2-A;10-BC fire extinguisher are required per 40' x 40' booth.
  - b. If frying any items, one fire extinguisher must meet the requirements as in 7 below for Type Kextinguishers.
- C. Generators and other internal combustion power sources shall be separated from tents, canopies or membrane structures by a minimum of 20 feet and shall be isolated from contact with the public by fencing, enclosure or other approved means
- D. Tents / Canopies The number, location, and width of all exits must meet the requirements of IFC-2006.
  a. All booths must have an unobstructed path of egress to the exit.
  - b. Tens, canopies, or membrane structures shall be adequately roped, braced, and anchored towithstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing.

#### 9. Services provided

- **A.** Public Restroom Facilities Public restroom facilities are available in the Texas Renaissance Festival Camping Grounds and other designated areas of the cook-off site.
- B. Trash Pickup Trash pick-up will be provided starting on Friday and continue during the course of the Cook-off. Please do not pack trash bags excessively full. Any bags that break will be left for the Team to promptly re-bag for pick-up. All bagged trash shall be placed outside the Team space for pick up.
- C. Water Water will be available on the site but not convenient. Please provide your own container.
- **D.** Grease No Grease of any kind shall be allowed to be poured or run on to the ground. All grease must be placed in a spill proof container that will not leak for final placement in the on-site dumpsters.
- E. Gray Water Gray Water from dishwashing, cooking and cooking pots shall not be allowed to be poured out to run freely onto the ground.

#### 10. IBCA Cook-Off

#### 11. General Information

- A. Danny Dietz Memorial Classic BBQ Cook-Off committee and their representatives shall not be responsible or liable for any theft or damage to any participant's equipment or supplies.
- B. Danny Dietz Memorial Classic BBQ Cook-Off committee and their representatives, reserve the right to delete, amend, modify, add rules and/or regulations as situations warrant. All decisions regarding individual Team space placement and/or Team space reassignment of the Danny Dietz Memorial Classic BBQ Cook-Off committee and deemed in their estimation to be what is best and shall be final.
- C. The Head Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guests. Misuse of alcoholic beverages and / or unacceptable conduct will be grounds of disqualification and forfeiture of awards. Glass bottles are not permitted in the contest area.
- D. Consumption of alcohol by minors is illegal and will not be permitted on Texas Renaissance Festival Camping Grounds. Individuals of teams caught making alcohol available to minors will be excluded from this and all future competitions. The DDMC Cook-off has a <u>Zero Tolerance Policy</u>.
- E. Danny Dietz Memorial Classic BBQ Cook-Off committee will provide Entertainment on Saturday after the Awards Ceremony. All Teams will be required to turn off their music at a designated time as not to conflict with the Entertainment and Awards Ceremony.

#### JPA Mission Statement:

Encouraging constructive family time while cultivating the beneficial skills of grilling and the virtues of winning and losing.

#### DDMC KIDS QUE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### ELIGIBITY:

- Cooks must be at least 7 years of age and no older than 17 on the date of the event (09/11/2021).
- Cooks must be able to trim, season, cook and present their steak entirely unassisted.

#### **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. Cook entrants will be divided into two groups:
  - a. Junior Division: 7-12 years of age
  - b. Senior Division: 13-17 years of age
- 2. Registration and cooks meeting will begin at 9am in designated area.
- 3. All cooking will be done in the designated cooking area.
- 4. Parents may help cooks set up their stations; however, they must leave the designated cooking area once their cook has picked their steaks.
- 5. Parents may re-enter the cooking area only after ALL contestants have turned in their steaks for judging.
- 6. No coaching or assistance of any kind will be permitted from outside the designated cooking area.
- 7. There will be one JPA Ambassador for every 2 cooks whenever possible.
- 8. Cooks may only address the JPA Ambassadors with questions.
- 9. JPA ambassadors will assist contestants with their fire, if needed, and will continue to monitor the fires throughout the event.
- 10. Cell Phones are PROHIBITED in the cooking area.

You will need to turn in **ONE** of the two steaks provided for judging. You will also be provided your turn in box and foil sheet. The same pits and charcoal will be provided to all cooks. These steaks may be seasoned in any way using the seasonings/sauces you provide. There will a small assortment of seasoning provided at your prep table as a courtesy, along with cutting board, gloves, and disinfectant wipes. Turn in will be at 9:30am. Awards will be with the IBCA awards. Most importantly, BE SAFE & HAVE FUN!

Your child's safety is our utmost concern, Trimming and injecting are allowed only if your child is guaranteed to do so entirely unassisted. Our Ambassadors have strict instruction not to assist the cook's preparation in any manner other than to start their fire and monitor each child to ensure safe practices are being used. However, if at any point, and Ambassador feels the child is using unsafe practices, the Ambassador will have the authority to step in and cease the unsafe practice immediately.
