All spaces are on a first come first serve basis based on time of registration form and payment received. Payment is required to secure a spot. All spaces are 30’X30. Electric and water will not be supplied.

GENERAL RULES

1. All teams must have a fire extinguisher at their site.
2. Team will consist of head cook and up to 4 team members.
3. Teams must supply all supplies need. Promoter will only provide space.
4. No electric or water hookups—please bring your own water and generator.
5. Trash bags and dumpster will be available. Please keep your areas clean and free of trash.
6. Please be respectful of the parking lot conditions. Keep all grease and food products on your trailer or on a tarp.
7. No 4 wheelers or golf carts in cook-off area except by the cook-off promoter.
8. IBCA judging rules will apply and decisions of head judge and committee will be final.
9. Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
10. Music should be played in moderation and must be turned off by 9 pm Friday and midnight on Saturday night. No music during awards. Be respectful of other teams and keep music volume within your area.
11. Upon arrival, meats will be inspected at check in and you may proceed to your assigned cooking spot after check in. Your team MUST stay within your boundaries. NO EXCEPTIONS
12. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks and other building materials or props hauled away and all equipment removed from the site by Sunday, May 22nd at NOON.
13. Teams participating in the contest must not damage in any way the premises on which the contest is being conducted. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES are there to be any stakes driven into the asphalt/concrete or any open fires on the grounds. All fires must be contained in a fireproof container. All drippings from BBQ pit must be contained. Please be sure to bag and dispose of properly. Security and safety are the sole responsibility of each team/contestant.
