V.F.W. POST 8905 AUXILIARY 2021 BAR-B-Q COOK OFF RULES AND REGULATIONS

Introduction:

- 1. The contest will be limited to the space available. Cooking spots will be on a first come first serve basis.
- 2. Contestant must supply all needed equipment and supplies. The Bar-B-Q management will supply space only.
- 3. V.F.W. Post 8905, the Bar-B-Q committee and any of their representatives will not be held responsible for any theft, damage, or injury.
- 4. The Bar-B-Q Committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situation warrants.
- 5. Decisions of the Bar-B-Q Committee and judges will be final.

Administration:

- 6. Contestants can check in and set up their space Thursday afternoon but must be set up by Saturday morning, September 11, 2021. Checking in after this time will require the prior approval of the BAR-B-Q Committee.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the Bar-B-Q Team to keep their area clean and assist with garbage disposal. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 8. The Chief Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his or her team and their guests. Beer and soft drinks will be available to the public at concession stands.

Note: State Law requires that you be 21 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages.

- 9. Each team will have a committee member assigned to them to help with any questions.
- 10. Dogs are allowed but must be friendly, kept in team area and be on leash.
- 11. For safety reasons, no golf carts, bicycles, water balloons, slingshots, firearms, etc. will be allowed in the contest area.
- 12. <u>For Safety Reasons</u>: Gate will be closed at 9:00 p.m. on Friday night and remained closed until after Awards Ceremony.
- 13. Outside beer or wine is not allowed. Teams may BYOB and purchase set-ups from the Canteen.
- 14. All contestants and guests must wear shirts and footwear on premises.

Cooking:

15. **Brisket-** Seven (7) full slices. Blocking Brisket ends is allowed. The fat cap may be trimmed or cut away before the slices are placed into the tray. Brisket must be placed in the tray parallel to the hinge. May not be salted, seasoned or marinated prior to inspection and tagging. Inspection and tagging will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, September 10, 2021. Each team may have a MAXIMUM of two briskets inspected and tagged. No meat to be brought on or taken off premises after inspection.

The Post will provide a witness for cutting. NO Throw Down Brisket!

- 16. **Pork Spareribs-** Seven (7) individual cut ribs (bone in) (St. Louis Cut acceptable) Ribs must be placed in tray MEAT side up lying parallel to the hinge, Baby back or Country Style Ribs are not permitted.
- 17. **Chicken** One (1) ½ fully jointed chicken MEAT side up (to include breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick). SKIN ON (No Cornish Game Hens.
- 18. **Open -** These will not be tagged, but all seasoning and cooking must be done in the cook off area. Open category will be MEAT ONLY. (NO DESERTS)
- 19. A Chief Cooks meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, September 10, 2021.
- 20. All winners will be announced, and awards presented after completion of Brisket Judging.
- 21. Contestants must have their equipment out of the cook off area by 12:00 noon Sunday, September 12, 2021.
- 22. Each team is to donate at least one item for the silent auction. Donations should be turned into Post by Friday, September 10, 2021.
- 23. Bean category-Pinto beans only. Nothing in the beans larger than a bean.

There is a \$5.00 entry fee for the Bloody Mary. Entry is optional, first place winner receives all the money. Jack Pot Beans is \$5.00 entry (optional). All money to the first place winner.
